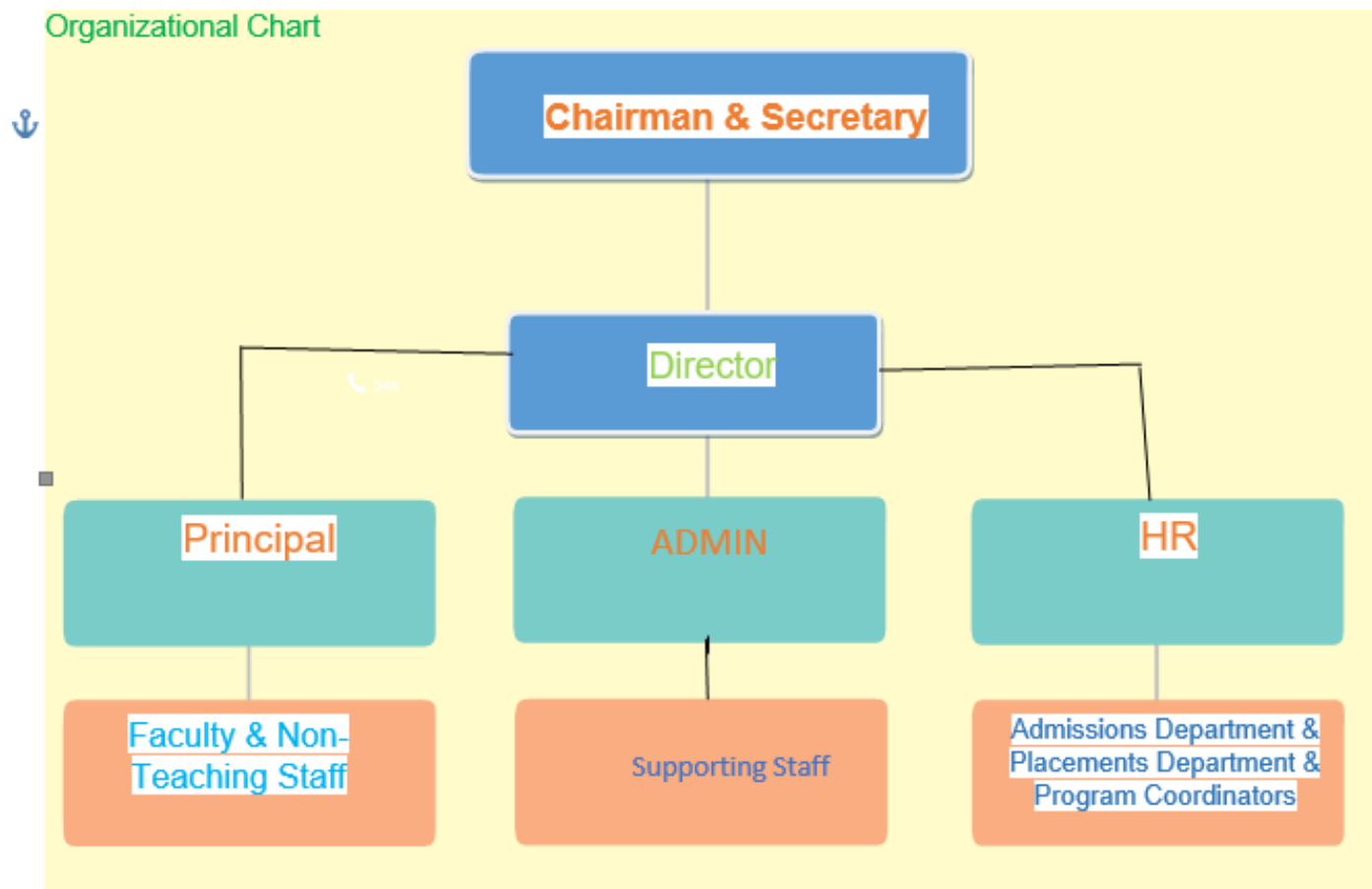

Eligibility Criteria

1. Candidates with minimum 50% in graduation in any discipline (45% for Reserve Categories) from a recognized university with a valid score in national level entrance tests ICET are eligible to apply.

Admission Process

1. Candidates can apply online or download application form from the website and send the same duly filled with an amount of Rs. 500/- by cash or DD in the name of VIVEKANANDA Educational Society.

Loans and Scholarships

Infrastructure Details: 3.2-acre campus

The campus of Vivekananda educational Society is located at a Shadnagar town, 45 kilometers from the city of Hyderabad, Telangana. The campus is named after the beautify ' trees that grown in this area. The campus is 29 kms from Rajiv Gandhi International Airport and 50kms from Secundrabad railway station.

Infrastructure
